A multi-talented composer and keyboard artist, Phillip Keveren displays a tremendous versatility in both his original works and concert performances. He composes in a variety of genres, and is widely acclaimed for his piano publications.

Mr. Keveren is a prolific arranger, orchestrator and producer. His work is featured in numerous instrumental recordings (including Discovery House Music's *Classical Praise* series), church choral, educational piano and Christian artist releases. His arrangements and compositions appear on recent projects by Sandi Patty (Max Lucado's 3:16 – Songs of Hope), Travis Cottrell, Sara Groves and Ronan Tynan.
